at Tel Aviv University by The Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust for the new Helmsley Medical Simulation Center.

The call will provide partial scholarships to outstanding students undertaking research in a broad range of research topics within simulation-based healthcare education, including, but not limited to, development and validation of simulation scenarios, assessment tools for simulation-based education, and technology and its integration in healthcare education.

ELIGIBILITY

- Full time PhD students at Tel Aviv University.
- PhD students with a BSc, MSc minimum average of 85 and a thesis grade of 90 or above.
- Endorsement and recommendation by the PhD advisor required.
- The student must dedicate maximum time and energy to their studies and research.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Candidates who meet the criteria above are requested to download the application form, fill it out and have it signed by their advisor.
- All documents (except letters of recommendation) should be submitted in one PDF through the website.
- Letters of recommendation should be sent by the advisor directly to kersha@tauex.tau.ac.il (letters submitted by students will not be accepted).
- DEADLINE: December 7, 2025

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The partial scholarships will be awarded for the period January 1, 2026 September 30, 2026.
- Recipients must provide an annual research report.
