

## The Cancer Biology Research Center - CBRC 2026 TRAVEL GRANTS - Call for Applications

The Cancer Biology Research Center (CBRC) offers travel grants of up to \$500 each, partially supporting active participation in international conferences, workshops, or courses. **Tel Aviv University** students, post-doctoral fellows, medical students, residents, and research associates are invited to submit applications. Grants are offered only to cover active participation in meetings relevant to cancer research held abroad until **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026**. The entitlement may be exercised for up to six months from receiving our notice regarding the requested meeting abroad. **Depending on the number of applications submitted, grants may be limited to 1 student per meeting and/or lab.**

Only students who did not receive CBRC travel grants in the last 2 years can apply.

Applicants should submit:

- CV (short) - **NIH style – up to 3 pages**
- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor - up to one page.
- Research Abstract as submitted to the meeting (including title, authors, and affiliations)- up to one page.
- Details of the conference, workshop, or course (including date and location).

**Applications not conforming to the requested format will not be considered.**
