Conclusions

On serology: One rat (51LS room 17) was found positive for **RTV** antibodies and one rat (52LS room 18) was found for *Pneumocystis carinii*.

On PCR: One rat (52LS room 18) was found positive for *Helicobacter rodentium*.(gut)

On parasitology: All test results were found negative

On bacteriology: One rat (52LS room 18) was found positive for *Pasteurella pneumotropica*.(naso)

NOTE: Viridans group alpha *Streptococcus*, coagulase negative *Staphylococcus sp*,
Enterococcus sp., *Lactobacillus sp.*, *Lactococcus sp.*, and *Escherichia coli* were isolated.
These bacteria are common components of the micro flora.

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
